DAY 1 Saturday, February 15: Welcome to Mexico City!

Depart Los Angeles International Airport via American Airlines to Mexico City.

Arrive at Mexico City Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager/guide as we exit Customs. Continue to our hotel for check-in.

Option: Attend the 5:00 p.m. Public Mass at the Metropolitan Cathedral.

Return to our hotel to freshen up.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mexico City. (D)

DAY 2 <u>Sunday, February 16: Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine</u> | <u>National Palace | Metropolitan Cathedral</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Board our private motor coach to transfer to the shrine. Along the way we will pass the Plaza of Three Cultures. The name "Three Cultures" is in recognition of the three periods of Mexican history reflected by the buildings we will see: Pre-Columbian, Spanish Colonial, and the independent "Mestizo" nation. Celebrate Mass at the Church of Santiago Tlatelolco. After Mass, we'll continue to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our guided visit of the modern-day circular basilica includes a viewing of the miraculous tilma containing the image of the Virgin. We'll explore important sites within the shrine domain, beginning at Tepeyac Hill, where Our Lady first appeared to Juan Diego in 1531 and offered him a bouquet of flowers that supposedly never withered. We will visit the Guadalupe Museum and nearby garden, with a beautiful representation of the moment Juan Diego showed the cloak to the archbishop. We will also visit the Chapel of the Indians and Church for Capuchin nuns. Our shrine visit concludes at the Old Basilica at the foot of Tepeyac Hill. Independent lunch, with time to visit the shop in the lower basilica.

After lunch, we pass by the National Palace, where Diego Rivera's paintings are on display. We will then head over to the Zocalo, the main square in Mexico City, where we will view the Templo Mayor (from outside), built in the 14th century in honor of the Aztec god of war and god of water. Continue to the oldest and largest cathedral in the Americas, Metropolitan Cathedral. It is considered the focus of Mexico's cultural heritage and remains the seat of the Archdiocese of Mexico City. Beneath the cathedral, in the Crypt of the Archbishops, the tombs of many prior archbishops of Mexico City can be found, including that of the city's first archbishop, Juan de Zumarraga.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mexico City. (B,D)

DAY 3 Monday, February 17: Cuernavaca | Taxco

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will drive to Cuernavaca (1.5 hours) to visit the beautiful cathedral. The cathedral began as a Franciscan Monastery where numerous Franciscans were trained and set out on their arduous journey to evangelize the orient and found new missions in the Philippines and Asia. The most famous of these friars was *Philip of Jesus*, the first Mexican martyr and saint. Crucified with 26 other religious martyrs by the Japanese Emperor Hideyoshi in 1596, Philip is memorialized in Cuernavaca Cathedral by a spectacular collection of nave murals, uncovered during renovation of the cathedral some years ago. The convent also contains many early murals, including a crucifixion and a unique spiritual genealogy of St. Francis in the cloister. **At 11:00 a.m., celebrate Mass at the Tercera Orden Chapel.** Independent lunch.

Continue to Taxco (1.5 hours) for a city tour. This antique silver-mining center is in the northern reaches of Guerrero. The city is well-known for its traditional silverwork. It's built on the side of a mountain, with very steep narrow cobblestone streets lined by whitewashed houses with red-tiled roofs. It is also renowned for its 18th century baroque style church, Santa Prisca Cathedral. Return to Mexico City.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mexico City.

DAY 4 <u>Tuesday, February 18: Excursion to Tlaxacala | Ocotlan |</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Today, board our private coach and enjoy a scenic ride through the mountains as we travel to Tlaxcala and the Shrine of St. Michael the Archangel (San Miguel Del Milagro). **Upon arrival, attend Holy Mass at the site where St. Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631**, directing him to the Grotto and a well of miraculous curative waters. We'll continue to Ocotlan to visit the beautiful church and see the miraculous image of Our Lady burnt into a tree trunk after she appeared to Juan Diego Bernardino in 1541. Perfectly preserved, the image in a tree resides in the Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan. Continue to Puebla, the City of Angels. Independent lunch in Puebla.

Enjoy an afternoon sightseeing in this beautiful historic city. What is most imposing is the Immaculate Conception Cathedral, built during the 16th century and topped by a dome of tile and two domed steeples. Then we'll visit the "Hidden Convent" of Santa Monica, one of the most important Catholic shrines of Puebla; the Church of Santo Dominigo with its magnificent Chapel of the Rosary, whose carved gilt altar is truly a work of art; the House of the "Alfenique;" and the Santa Rosa Convent, known as the Ceramics Museum. Then, we'll visit the Church of San Francisco, where we will learn the story of Blessed Sebastian de la Aparicio and view his incorrupt body. Return to Mexico City. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mexico City. (B,D)

DAY 5 Wednesday, February 19: Mexico City | Tulpetlac | Teotihuacan

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll visit the beautiful Church of the Holy Family, which houses the martyred remains of a young Jesuit priest named Fr. Miguel Pro. Learn of his brave story of martyrdom. At the time of his death on November 23, 1927, Mexico was under rule of the fiercely anti-clerical and anti-Catholic President Plutarco Elias Calles, who had begun a persecution of religion. S.J. Blessed Miguel Pro was beatified by Pope John Paul II on September 25, 1988. Continue to Tulpetlac, where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Juan Diego's uncle, Juan Bernadino, and healed him of a fatal illness. Reflect on Our Lady's call to penance, prayer, and devotion to her Immaculate Heart as well as her tender motherly appearances to Juan Diego, which gave us a message of hope and comfort. **At 10:00 a.m., celebrate Mass at Tulpetlac Church.** Independent lunch.

We will then proceed to Teotihuacan, the country's true first city. Teotihuacan, "the place where the gods were created," thrived between 500 B.C. and 700 A.D. We will explore the ancient Pyramids of the Sun and Moon, the grand Avenue of the Dead, the Temple of Quetzalcoatl and others. Return to Mexico City.

Tonight, enjoy Mexican dining and entertainment at Villa Maria. This unique place combines traditional folk music with local delicacies. Overnight at our hotel in Mexico City. (B,D)

DAY 6 Thursday, February 20: Return to the USA

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will be transferred to Mexico City International Airport for our return flight home. (B)

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$445 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are
