Day 1 December 26, Tuesday: Depart USA

"...witness to all the nations..."(Matthew 24:14)

Depart New York's JFK International Airport on EL AL Israel Airlines for our Pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B,L)

Day 2 December 27, Wednesday: Arrive Tel Aviv | Caesarea by the Sea | Sea of Galilee

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and soon, we will be on our way to Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here also that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. After our visit we continue to the Sea of Galilee. **Celebrate Mass in the guesthouse chapel.**

Check-in, dinner, and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (D)

Day 3 December 28, Thursday: Cana | Nazareth | Mt. Carmel

Theme: The Annunciation: ...The Word became flesh...(John 1:14).

Buffet breakfast at hotel. We will begin our day in Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. ...*"Do whatever he tells you."* (John 2:5) Visit the Wedding Church, see the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows. Continue to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation or Church of St. Joseph in Nazareth.** After Mass, visit St. Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Walk through the streets and imagine a day in the life of the Holy Family. Independent lunch in Nazareth. Continue Mt. Carmel and a visit to Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. See Elijah's cave. Return to the Sea of Galilee with the remainder of the afternoon at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 4 December 29, Friday: Sea of Galilee Area | Mount of Beatitudes | Magdala

Theme: The Ministry of Christ in Galilee

Breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as you imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). Arrive at the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus worked many miracles and called Matthew to discipleship. Here, the excellent condition of a 2nd century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. At Tabgha, Jesus challenged His disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter. Here, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to *"feed my lambs; feed my sheep"*. Next we visit the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus found Matthew and called him to discipleship. Jesus worked many of His miracles in Capernaum. Here, the excellent condition of a 2nd century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. Independent lunch. After lunch we will visit Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus offered His 'Sermon on the Mount.' You will be taken by the peaceful retreat-like setting overlooking the Sea of Galilee. The quiet gardens and scenic view makes this a perfect location to pause and spend some time in contemplation of Jesus' public ministry. **Celebrate Mass on the Mount of Beatitudes.** End our day with a visit to Migdal, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. Explore the excavation discovered by the Legionaries of Christ and learn about one of the most important archeological excavations made in the Holy Land in the past years.

Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

Day 5 December 30, Saturday: Mt. Tabor | Jericho | Jerusalem

Theme: The Transfiguration

Breakfast at hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. Leave the Sea of Galilee for Mt. Tabor. The elevation provides an utterly commanding view of all of Galilee. Visit the site of the Transfiguration, with time to reflect on Christ's humanity and Divinity, good preparation for the journey to Jerusalem.

Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration. Continue our journey through the Jordan Valley. Independent lunch upon arrival in Jericho. After lunch we will explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles and the Mt. of Temptation. Near the center of the city, a centuries-old sycamore tree recalls the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus, too short to see over the crowd, climbed a sycamore's branches in order to see Jesus. Then, we will make a brief stop at the Jordan River, the traditional Baptismal site and the Dead Sea before we continue our journey "up to Jerusalem" from the shoreline of the lowest point on earth. Upon arrival, check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 December 31, Sunday: Bethlehem | Ein Karem | Israel Museum

Theme: The Nativity & Palm Sunday, the Agony in the Garden.

Begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Upon arrival we will visit Shepherds' Field, to explore some of the caves typical of the stables in the time of Jesus' birth. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! **Celebrate Mass in the Church of St. Catherine or one of the Grotto Chapels beneath the Basilica of the Nativity.** Visit the nearby Milk Grotto, a site according to tradition where the Blessed Mother while nursing Jesus, a drop of her milk fell on the floor and the whole grotto turned white. Free time will be given for shopping and browsing in Manger Square. Independent lunch. After lunch we will visit Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth and Zachariah, and birthplace of St. John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Time will be given for quiet meditation as we pray the verses from the *Magnificat*, engraved on the columns of the church, and on opposite walls in forty-two different languages. On our return to Jerusalem we will visit the Israel Museum. Among many works we will see a model of Jerusalem in the Second Temple Period, which reconstructs the topography and architectural character of the city as it was in the days of Jesus.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 7 January 1, Monday: (Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God), Old City | Temple Mount | Yad Vashem | Mount Zion

Theme: Early years in Jerusalem

After breakfast, we will explore the Old City beginning with the Pools of Bethesda and a visit to the Church of St. Anne in the Muslim Quarter of the old city of Jerusalem. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Anne.** Continue to the area of the Temple Mount to see the Western Wall (*Ophel Hill*). Walk through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem seeing the Pinnacle of the Temple (*Gate of Hulda*). After Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized). We will also visit the newly constructed Jewish Quarter "*Cardo*." Independent lunch. Afternoon visits on Mt. Zion include the Cenacle (*Upper Room*), Dormition Abbey and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Visit Yad Vashem, the memorial to the victims of the Holocaust. See the Children's Pavilion and walk along the Avenue of the Righteous. Balance of the afternoon is at leisure. **Today's Mass will be St. Anne's Church or Sisters or Zion.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 January 2, Tuesday: Mount of Olives | Evening Holy Hour

Theme: Palm Sunday, the Agony in the Garden

After breakfast, drive to the top of the Mount of Olives, where we will visit the shrine of the Ascension, the Church of the Pater Noster and walk the Palm Sunday path. We will **celebrate Mass at Dominus Flevit Church** (*The Lord Wept*). Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Independent lunch. Enjoy a full afternoon at leisure to explore Jerusalem on your own.

Option: This evening, return to the Church of All Nations in the Garden of Gethsemane for a Eucharistic Holy Hour.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 9 January 3, Wednesday: Via Crucis | Emmaus | Farewell Dinner

Theme: The Crucifixion & The Resurrection

After breakfast drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Continue to the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried, condemned to be crucified, and carried the Cross along the Via Dolorosa. We will walk and pray the Stations of the Cross, ending in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** After Mass, we will have a formal guided tour of the Basilica with the extraordinary opportunity to enter and exit the Empty Tomb! Independent lunch in Jerusalem. This afternoon, we will visit one of the traditional Emmaus sites (Abu Gosh). We will recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road after the Resurrection. Time will be given for prayer and reflection in the Church of Our Lady of the Ark of the Covenant. **Return to Jerusalem for our group farewell dinner at the Ambassador hotel.** Following dinner, you will have an opportunity to freshen-up before your evening transfer to Tel Aviv Airport for your return flight to the USA.

Overnight on non-stop flight to the USA. (B,D)

Day 10 January 4, Thursday: Return to the USA

Early morning, arrive in New York, overflowing with memories that will change your life.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. Package prices are \$100.00 higher per person when using a credit card as form of payment as the package price shown on the brochure reflects a cash discount. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 non-refundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least **six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, current, and in good condition. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from JFK New York on EL AL Israel Airlines. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**\$1,795.00 per person, sharing a twin room**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an **additional charge of \$595.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to

match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, **including farewell dinner** prior to departure. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is \$7.00 per passenger per day; to the driver is \$3.00 per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the waiters after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for the maid/bell boys.
