DAY 1 Monday, September 23: Depart for Greece

Transfer by private motorcoach from the Church of the Gesu to Detroit Metro Airport. Depart Detroit Metro Airport on our flight to Thessaloniki, Greece. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B) and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Tuesday, September 24: Arrive in Thessaloniki

Arrive at Thessaloniki International Airport, go through Customs, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit baggage claim. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Thessaloniki for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Thessaloniki. (B,D)

DAY 3 <u>Wednesday, September 25: Thessaloniki | Kavala | Philippi</u> Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will tour Thessaloniki, the second largest city in Greece and the capital of Macedonia where Paul preached and founded a church. The New Testament books of Thessalonians are his correspondence with the people of this church. See the ramparts of the city; the triumphal Arch of Galerius starting the Via Egnatia, once a strategic artery of the Roman Empire; and the Roman Agora where Paul preached. Visit St. Demetrios Church with its valuable mosaics and frescoes, then drive to the upper town, which offers a marvelous view of the city. After our visit, continue on to Kavala (the ancient Neapolis) where Paul, Timothy and Silas landed on the coast of Thrace. Then, visit Philippi, where Paul won his first European convert, a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira. Tour the Baptistery of St. Lydia, the market place where Paul and Silas were brought before the rulers, and the cistern which tradition identifies as the place where Paul was imprisoned. **Celebrate Mass.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Thessaloniki. (B,D)

DAY 4 <u>Thursday, September 26: Veria | Meteora | Kammena Vourla</u> Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Thessaloniki to visit Veria (ancient Beria) to see the memorial commemorating Paul's preaching to the local Jews in 54 AD. Part of the Roman road, the Egnatia Way, is still visible today in Veria today. **Celebrate Mass at the Bema in Veria.** Independent lunch.

This afternoon, continue to the area of Kalambaka for an amazing view of the monastaries with dozens of rock pillars jutting up out of the plain. Christian hermits lived in the caves in these rocks beginning in 985 and then, beginning in the 14th century, monasteries were founded and built on top of many of these towers. The region is known as Meteora, Greek for "suspended." These "monasteries hanging in the air" are a major center of Eastern Orthodox spirituality. We will visit one of the six monasteries that are still active. Then, we'll continue to Kammerna Vourla for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kammena Vourla. (B,D)

DAY 5 Friday, September 27: Aegean Greek Islands Cruise | Mykonos | Sail to Kusadasi

Breakfast at our hotel. **This morning we will be transferred to St. Paul Church in Piraeus for morning Mass.** After Mass, we will travel to Piraeus Harbor in time for the 11:30 a.m. boarding of the cruise ship *Celestyal Olympia*. Lunch on board is included.

Arrive in Mykonos. Enjoy this paradise island known for its nightlife, beautiful beaches, boutiques, and cuisine. This Greek island has hundreds of tiny chapels dotting the landscape and sheep grazing in the shadow of white washed windmills. While on Mykonos, you are free to explore on your own. Dinner and overnight aboard *Celestyal Olympia*. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 <u>Saturday, September 28: Cruise to Kusadasi | Patmos |</u> <u>Overnight Sail to Crete</u>

Arrive in Kusadasi. Disembark and travel by bus to Ephesus, the best preserved of the Seven Churches of Revelation (Rev. 2.1-7). We will visit the

ancient city with its impressive temples, marble streets, library, agoras, baths, and theater that seats 24,000 people. We will also visit the House of the Virgin Mary–one tradition says this is the place where St. John brought Mary after the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. **Celebrate Mass at the House of the Virgin Mary**.

Sail to Patmos. Arrive near the island of Patmos, and transfer by boat to the "Holy Island" known as the site of the apocalyptic Revelation of John, written here during his exile from the Roman Empire. The cave where St. John lived is near the site of the Monastery of the Apocalypse. Visit the Monastery of St. John, built on one of the island's highest points, which houses priceless icons.

All meals and overnight aboard Celestyal Olympia. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 <u>Sunday, September 29: Heraklion (Crete) | Santorini |</u> <u>Overnight Sail to Pireaus</u>

Arrive in Heraklion, the capital of Crete and its principal commercial port (Shore excursion is included).

Afternoon sail to Santorini. Arrive in Santorini, the Island which some believe to be the site of the lost city of Atlantis (*Shore excursion is included*). Spend time in the village of Fira, perched on the rim of a crater formed by a volcano that destroyed the island in about 1630 B.C. Take the cable car to the top or ride a donkey up a zigzag path. There are many interesting shops, and it is easy to find a cafe or taverna that has a spectacular view. **Celebrate Mass on board the cruise ship.**

This evening, we'll sail overnight to Piraeus Harbor in Athens. All meals and overnight aboard Celestyal Olympia. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 Monday, September 30: Piraeus | Corinth | Athens

Dock at Piraeus. After an early breakfast, disembark and begin our day with an excursion to Corinth (Acts 18.1-18). Stop briefly en route to see the Corinth Canal, the famous man-made construction named one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Continue to Corinth, where St. Paul wrote the First Letter to the Thessalonians and, most likely, his Letter to the Romans. Explore the extensive archeological site, including the Temple of Apollo, the Roman Agora, and the Bema–where Paul's enemies brought him before Gallo. See the pavement inscription of Erastus, the Roman Lechaion Road, the lower Fountain of Peirene, and the imposing Acrocorinth, an 1,800-foot hill that rises high above the ancient city. In the first century, there were many shrines and temples dominated by the Temple of Aphrodite. It was also the location of a series of fortifications built during ancient and medieval times that continued through the successive chain of Franco, Byzantine, Venetian, and Turkish supremacy. **Celebrate Mass outdoors in Corinth.**

Independent lunch. After lunch, we'll continue to Athens for hotel check-in. Overnight at our hotel in Athens. (B,D)

DAY 9 Tuesday, October 1: Athens | Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. **Begin our day with Mass at the Roman Catholic Cathedral of St. Dennis or at Sacred Heart Church.** After Mass, we will explore the most famous site in Greece: the Athens Acropolis and famed Parthenon. Visit Mars Hill, where Paul addressed the councilors and philosophers of the Areopagus. Continue our Athens orientation tour passing by the Olympic Stadium of 1896, Temple of Zeus, Royal Palace, Syndagma Square, Memorial to the Unknown Soldiers, Arch of Hadrian, Hadrian's Wall, the Olympic Complex of 2004 Games, and the Academy University National Library. Independent lunch.

Late afternoon, we will visit the Plaka, a lively historic neighborhood nestled at the foot of the Acropolis. **Feast on local cuisine and enjoy fine wine in a traditional tavern with Greek entertainment.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Athens.

DAY 10 Wednesday, October 2: Return to the USA

Early morning, we'll be transferred to Athens International Airport for our return flight to Detroit. Upon arrival, private coach transfer will be provided from Detroit Metro International Airport to the Church of the Gesu parking lot.

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card.
