DAY 1 <u>Sunday, June 22: Depart for Italy</u> Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport on the overnight flight to Venice, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Monday, June 23: Welcome to Venice | Mestre

Arrive at Venice International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way for hotel check-in in Mestre. Balance of the day at leisure. (D)

Welcome dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mestre.

DAY 3 <u>Tuesday, June 24: Highlight Tour of Venice | Free Afternoon</u> After breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to the pier for a boat transfer to St.

Mark's Square to explore this lovely and famous lagoon city on the Adriatic Coast. Celebrate Mass at St. Mark's Basilica, sung by St. Anthony Camerata Chorale. After Mass, begin our day with a walking tour of Venice's hub of activity, Piazza San Marco, which is lined with galleries, luxury shops, and charming cafes. Dominating the square is the magnificent Basilica San Marco, where the mixture of styles-Byzantine, Romanesque, and Gothic-and profuse decoration reflect Venice's history. Marvel at the shimmering mosaics encrusted on its interior walls, the precious sculptures, and rare marbles. Admire the Campanile, having simple lines contrasting sharply with the sumptuous decor of the church and clock tower, where famous Moors have been striking the hours for over 500 years. Continue to the Bridge of Sighs, which connects to the Doge's Palace and the Piombi Prisons. The bridge is so named because of the sad laments of the prisoners as they were led across it to certain torture and possible death. Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore Venice on your own.

Don't miss out on an optional gondola trip, gliding along the picturesque canals with a local troubadour to serenade you. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Mestre.

DAY 4 Wednesday, June 25: Padua | Florence

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll leave Mestre to visit the lovely town of Padua and the Basilica of St. Anthony, with its famous Chapel of the Relics containing the actual tongue and lower jawbone of the saint. The basilica also contains a mixture of Gothic, Romanesque, and Byzantine architecture, holding a huge collection of art treasures. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Anthony. After our visit, we'll leave Padua to drive through the gentle Tuscan hills that for centuries have inspired saints, artists, and admirers of beauty to the Renaissance city of Florence. Independent lunch en route

A stop will be made at Piazzale Michelangelo, one of the best viewpoints in Florence to appreciate the panorama of the city. Check-in at our hotel in Florence and balance of the afternoon at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence.

DAY 5 Thursday, June 26: Highlights of Florence

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at St. Mark's Church, sung by St. Anthony Camerata Chorale. After Mass, our local guide will take us to visit the Accademia, which houses the sculpture of "David" by Michelangelo. Then, continue to the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo to see the delicately patterned green, white, and pink Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, crowned with Brunelleschi's magnificent dome. See Giotto's Bell Tower; the Romanesque Baptistery of St. John with Ğhiberti's exquisite bronze doors, which Michelangelo called the "Gates of Paradise"; and the 13th century Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross, which holds tombs of the greatest Florentine citizens.

Independent lunch and free afternoon to further explore Florence. Perhaps you'll visit the Uffizi Palace, which houses what may be the most important collection of paintings in the world. You could also visit the Piazza Della Signoria; the famous shop-lined bridge, Ponte Vecchio; or its adjacent market. For those that would like to shop, this is the best time to look for leather, gold, or other Florentine souvenirs. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Florence. (B)

DAY 6 Friday, June 27: Highlight Tour of Siena | Assisi

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Florence on our short excursion to visit Siena. We'll walk in the footsteps of St. Catherine in Siena, who lived from 1347 to 1380 as a lay affiliate of the Dominican Order. St. Catherine in Stena, who we from 1547 to 1530 mystical visions of Christ. Visit the Basilica of St. Dominic, just up the hill from her childhood home, and see the head of this beloved Patron Saint of Italy on display in a gilded reliquary. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, continue to the beautiful and elaborately decorated Duomo and Baptistery. Siena's Gothic Cathedral is full of treasures. The intricate floor mosaics, elaborate sculptures, and vivid frescoes were completed by the leading artists of the day. Time will be given to explore the Piazza del Campo (Il Campo). Independent lunch.

We'll continue to Assisi to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, which encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula" or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. After our visit, we'll check-in at our hotel in Assisi.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi.

DAY 7 <u>Saturday, June 28: Assisi | Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare |</u> <u>Rome</u>

After an early breakfast, celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis (subject to confirmation). After Mass, we'll have a guided tour of the basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare to view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Independent lunch

Time will be given to visit Piazza del Comune, Chiesa Nuova, the home and cloth workshops of Pietro Bernadone and Lady Pica (St. Francis' parents), the home of St. Clare's parents, the Bishop's Palace, or the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. The tomb of Bl. Carlo Acutis is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. You may pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. After our visit we'll continue to Rome, the "Eternal City."

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 8 Sunday, June 29: Papal Mass on the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul | Walking Tour of Central Rome After an early breakfast at our hotel, we'll be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to

attend the Papal Mass on the Solemnity of Ss. Peter & Paul, celebrated by His Holiness, Pope Francis. At noon, attend the Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, enjoy a guided walking tour of historic Rome, beginning at the Spanish Steps (Piazza di Spagna). Continue to the Trevi Fountain to toss in a coin and then visit the Pantheon. Built more than 1800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. Visit the nearby Church of St. Louis of the French to see three magnificent paintings by Baroque master Caravaggio: *Martyrdom* of St. Matthew, Calling of St. Matthew, and St. Matthew and the Angel. Our walking tour will conclude in the lively Piazza Navona, one of the most charming and popular squares in Rome. Time will be given to browse through the artists' stalls or relax and enjoy one of Rome's most famous frozen treats, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini. The gelato is delicious too! Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 9 Monday, June 30: The Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica |

Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel | Tour of the Colosseum After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass we will visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. In your free time, you may wish to return to the Vatican Crypt to pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we'll tour one of Rome's iconic attractions: the Colosseum. Learn about the rich history of this place, hear tales about the games that took place here, and enter through the gladiator gate to access the arena floor. (Colosseum tickets are subject to confirmation 90 days prior to arrival). Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 10 <u>Tuesday, July 1: St. Paul Outside-the-Walls | Monte Cassino</u> Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door," which are opened only during Jubilee years. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are medallions of each pope, from St. Peter to Pope Francis. After our visit, we'll leave Rome to visit the Benedictine Abbey of Monte Cassino. Independent lunch.

We'll visit the 5th century Abbey of Monte Cassino, the cradle of the Benedictine Order where the motherhouse of the Benedictines was founded by St. Benedict in 529 and the saint worked many miracles. We'll visit the Abbey with prayer service and reflection at the Tomb of St. Benedict. **Celebrate Mass at the Abbey.** After our visit, we'll return to our hotel to freshen-up.

Enjoy cocktails and a farewell dinner at the Terrace and Garden of Hotel Kolbe. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and taste wonderful Mediterranean cuisine in a Roman setting. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 11 Wednesday, July 2: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

AIR TRANSPORTATION: The travel package does not include airfare. Optional group airfare from Chicago will be offered as an add-on once a group booking and airfare have been confirmed. Flight itinerary and carrier to be advised in August 2024. You will have 3 to 5 days to either accept or decline the group airfare offering. If you choose to purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible if you cancel your participation in the tour for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT. PLEASE NOTE, under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,695 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend $\notin 4$ Euro per person per day for your tour manager; $\notin 2$ Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and $\notin 1.50$ Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package
