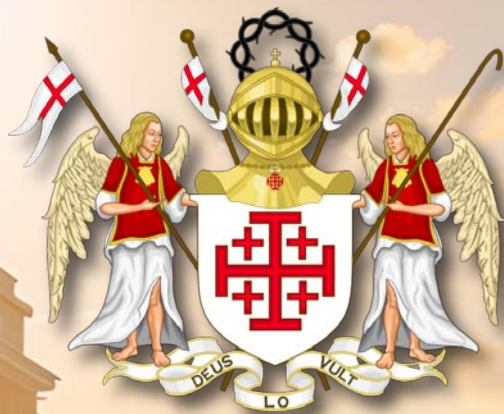

### DAY 1 Saturday, October 18: Depart for Italy

*Feast of Saint Luke, Evangelist*

Depart JFK International Airport for our overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

### DAY 2 Sunday, October 19: Welcome to Rome!

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way Tour Manager as we exit from Customs and Baggage Claim. Board our private touring bus and we'll be on our way to the Eternal City. If early check-in is not possible, an orientation tour will be arranged with a stop for **Mass at Santa Maria in Trastevere** followed by an independent lunch.

Check-in at our hotel in Rome. Afternoon at leisure.

Welcome dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (D)

### DAY 3 Monday, October 20: Excursion to Assisi

Early breakfast at our hotel. Then we'll leave Rome for Assisi. Upon arrival, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica of St. Francis. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare to view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix that spoke to St. Francis. **Celebrate Mass in Assisi.** Group lunch in Assisi.

After lunch, we'll also have the opportunity to visit Piazza del Comune, Chiesa Nuova, the home and cloth workshops of Pietro Bernadone and Lady Pica (St. Francis' parents), the home of St. Clare's parents, the Bishop's Palace, or the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. The tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Bl. Carlo Acutis, who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Next, we'll visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. A stop will be made en route back to Rome for an independent dinner.

### DAY 4 Tuesday, October 21: Papal Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls

Leisurely breakfast at our hotel. The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" that is opened only during Jubilee years. Today, we will pass through the holy door of one of the four major basilicas of Rome.

At 2:00 p.m., join fellow Knights and Ladies from around the world and enter through the Holy Door of the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century. St. Paul is buried in the confessor of this church. Above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom. These chains were placed in this prominent location in 2008. The main altar in the left transept is dedicated to the Conversion of St. Paul. The painting above this altar, completed by Vincenzo Camuccini, depicts this event. Other works of art include the tabernacle of the confessor by Arnolfo di Cambio, an exquisite 12th century candelabra by Vassalotto, a 13th century Byzantine style apse mosaic of Christ as the Pantokrator, and an attractive 19th century series of Papal portraits in a frieze extending around the nave. **Celebrate Holy Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul. Welcome greeting from the Cardinal Grand Master.** Independent dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

### DAY 5 Wednesday, October 22: Archbasilica of St. John Lateran | Basilica of St. Mary Major

*Feast of Saint John Paul II*

After an early breakfast, we'll begin our day by joining fellow Knights and Ladies as we enter through the Holy Door of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. The holy heads of St. Peter and St. Paul are enclosed in two ornate reliquaries high above the main altar. From there we will go to the Sanctuary of the Passion of Christ, which is under the care of the Passionists. **Celebration of Holy Mass.** Independent lunch.

Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. Pass through the Holy Door of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old

Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon *Salus Populi Romani*, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome.

Independent dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

### DAY 6 Thursday, October 23: St. Peter's Basilica | Closing Mass and Dinner

After an early breakfast, we'll make our way to St. Peter's Basilica. At 9:30 a.m. **we'll join fellow Knights and Ladies for an Audience with Pope Francis.** Afterward, pass through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica and **celebrate Mass with a final greeting of the Cardinal Grand Master.** Independent lunch. The afternoon is free to enjoy Rome on your own.

**This evening, we will gather for a celebratory dinner. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music.**

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

### DAY 7 Friday, October 24: Optional Visit to Pompeii

Early breakfast at our hotel. Free day in Rome or optional excursion to Pompeii.

**Optional excursion to Pompeii** (*additional cost to be advised*). We will depart Rome and drive south on the Autostrada del Sole (Sun Route) to Pompeii. Upon arrival we will visit the Shrine of the Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii. The painting of "Our Lady of the Rosary" with its bronze gilt frame is presented to the pilgrims on the high altar. The venerated painting depicts the Virgin Mary and Child Jesus presenting rosaries to St. Dominic and St. Catherine of Siena. Originally bought by Dominican Friar Alberto Radente, it was offered to Blessed Bartolo Longo on November 13, 1875, for the church he was building in Pompeii. Miracles began to be reported and pilgrims began flocking in droves to the church. At the request of Pope Pius XI, Bartolo Longo was invested with the insignia of Knight Grand Cross of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem in the Holy Year of 1925 by Patriarch Barlassina of the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II on October 26, 1980. (*Option to celebrate Mass at the Shrine to Our Lady.*) Independent lunch.

After lunch we will explore the incredibly well-preserved remains of the ancient Roman town of Pompeii, which was destroyed and buried during a long catastrophic eruption of the volcano Mount Vesuvius spanning two days in 79 A.D. The volcano collapsed higher roof-lines and buried Pompeii under 60 feet of ash and pumice. It was lost for nearly 1700 years until its accidental rediscovery in 1748. Since then, its excavation has provided an extraordinarily detailed insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire. Return to Rome with a stop for an independent dinner on our return.

### DAY 8 Saturday, October 25: Return Home

After breakfast, we'll be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our return flight back to the USA.

**PAYMENT:** All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour deposits are non-refundable upon receipt.** If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

**LATE RESERVATIONS:** Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

**AIRLINE SEATING:** Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,595.00 per person sharing a twin room** (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. **TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Portage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,395.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

**MEALS:** Breakfast daily plus one (1) lunch in Assisi and two (2) dinners.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro

per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.

**TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY:** Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others.
