DAY 1 Monday September 1: Depart USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport via British Airways for our pilgrimage to Rome, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Tuesday, September 2: Welcome to Rome!

Board our private touring bus and our guide will take us on an orientation tour of Rome. Visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum and see the Arch of Titus, the Arch of Constantine, and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Independent lunch. Continue to our hotel for check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (D)

DAY 3 Wednesday, September 3: Papal Audience | Papal Basilicas

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we will enter the heart of Christendom for the **weekly general audience with our Holy Father**. Pope Francis will greet all the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch. The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" which is opened only during Jubilee years. Our tour of the Papal Basilicas starts with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament and venerate relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.** Continue to the **Cathedral of St. John Lateran**, the first Christian church to be consecrated. From there we'll pass by the **Holy Stairs**, said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. You can go up on your knees as thousands of pilgrims have done in reverently recalling the sufferings of Christ. Then, we will visit the **Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem**, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, September 4: Assisi

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we'll leave on our full day excursion to Assisi (2.5-hour drive). Upon arrival, we'll visit the **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli**, built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula" or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. Independent lunch. After lunch, our local guide will take us to visit the **Basilica of St. Clare**. View St. Clare's relics and see the miraculous Crucifix that spoke to St. Francis. Continue to visit the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. Pray near the **tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis**, the young Catholic from Italy who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Our walking tour continues to the **Basilica of St. Francis**, complex composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the **tomb of St. Francis. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis.** After Mass, we'll return to Rome.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 5 Friday, September 5: St. Peter's Basilica | Vatican Museums | St. Paul Outside-the-Walls | Catacombs

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. **Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels.** After Mass we will visit the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the magnificent frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. In your free time, you may wish to return to the Vatican Crypt to pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we'll visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century. St. Paul is buried in the confessio of this church and above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom. (Option: Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul). Visit the **Catacombs of St. Sebastian**. Walk through the maze of tunnels where early Christians secretly practiced religious rites and buried their dead. After our visit, we'll enjoy a **festive farewell dinner at a traditional Roman restaurant.** Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 6 Saturday, September 6: Rome to London

After an early breakfast, we'll be transferred to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport for our continuing flight to London. Late morning, we'll arrive at London Heathrow Airport, go through passport control, collect our luggage and meet our guide outside the customs hall. As rooms are unlikely to be ready yet, our guide will take us to visit **St. Paul's Cathedral**, designed by Sr. Christopher Wren in 1673. Followed by a visit to the **Tower of London**, which has protected, housed, and imprisoned many. The Tower of London has been the seat of British government and the living quarters of monarchs, as well as the site of renowned political intrigue and the repository of the Crown Jewels. It's also the execution site (commemorative plaque) of the scaffold at Tower Hill and where St. Thomas More and St. John Fisher were buried in the chapel of St. Peter ad Vincula. **Celebrate Mass (location to be advised).** Independent lunch.

During our orientation tour of London we'll pass the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Whitehall, Downing Street, Nelson's Column, Piccadilly Circus, and the London Eye. Check-in at our hotel in London. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in London. (B,D)

DAY 7 Sunday, September 7: Brompton Oratory | Free Time

English breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast we'll go to the Church of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, popularly known as the Brompton Oratory, the second largest Catholic Church in London. **Attend 11:00 am choral Mass at Brompton Oratory.** After Mass, enjoy free time at leisure for independent visits to the Museums, shopping at Harrods in Knightsbridge, take a ride on the London Eye, or take in a West End show. Independent lunch.

Mid-afternoon, we will gather back at the hotel to freshen up and go to Westminster Abbey for Evensong. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in London. (B)

DAY 8 Monday, September 8: Walsingham | Lincolnshire

English breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll leave London for Walsingham (3.5-hour drive). England's "Nazareth," a place of pilgrimage dating back to 1061. Here, Richeldis de Faverches had a vision of the Virgin Mary. In her appearance, seen in the setting of the house in Nazareth, she was given precise dimensions and instructed to build in her own village a replica of the house of the Annunciation. After the establishment of "Holy House," Walsingham became known as "Little Nazareth." See the Slipper Chapel, from which pilgrims, including Henry VIII, walked "the holy mile" barefoot to Nazareth House. **Celebrate Mass at the Slipper Chapel (or alternate chapel).** Independent lunch. **We'll continue to Sempringham to visit St. Andrew's Church, the home of our patron St. Gilbert.** In 1131 he founded the Gilbertine Order and constructed a dwelling and cloister for nuns north of the church of St. Andrew in Sempringham. After a brief prayer service, we'll visit the church and learn more about St. Gilbert's life and ministry. As the only St. Gilbert Parish in the United States, we'll surely feel a connection to the parish and create strong bonds with the congregants of St. Andrew's. Continue to Lincolnshire for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lincolnshire area. (B,D)

DAY 9 Tuesday, September 9: York

English breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave for York (3-hour drive). Independent lunch upon arrival. We'll take a stroll through York's medieval streets known as the "Shambles." See the famous house of St. Margaret Clitherow, the wife of a butcher who died when she refused to renounce the Catholic faith. She lived in this house and kept a small room to hide priests (Priest's hole) from persecution, but was arrested, tried, and crushed to death on March 25, 1586. She was canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1970. **Celebrate Mass (location to be advised).** Visit **York Minster Cathedral**, claimed to be the largest Gothic Cathedral north of the Alps. We'll also visit the **Bar Convent**, England's oldest living convent, founded in 1686 as a school for girls and still home to members of the Congregation of Jesus today. Check-in at our hotel in York. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in York. (B,D)

DAY 10 Wednesday, September 10: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we'll be transferred to Newcastle International Airport for our return flight to the USA. Arrive home the same day. (B)

Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Chicago. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: A group booking will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,495.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,095.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus four (4) dinners in Rome and three (3) dinners in England.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping. **(For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred).**

The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). **If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.** The insurance plan can be purchased at any time thereafter, excluding coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. **Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made. All plan payments are non-refundable.** If you choose to extend your stay or plan a pre-tour program, travel insurance can be purchased for an additional \$4.00 per day. Additional coverage needs to be requested. The insurance plan will not automatically be extended. The insurance plan will only cover pre-paid arrangements made through PWT. Benefits and services are provided by Travel Insured International. Upon claim approval, reimbursement is up to 100% of the non-refundable payments for your trip. **The Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) add-on can be purchased for an additional cost** (see pricing chart below). This includes reasons for cancellation not otherwise covered by the regular policy. You can cancel up to 2 days prior to departure and receive reimbursement of up to 80% of the non-refundable payments for your trip. Payment for CFAR must be included with your deposit at the time of enrollment. **CFAR coverage cannot be purchased by New York State residents as per state law.** Once you begin your trip, coverage under the plan will end as soon as you go back to your return destination. This means that if you return home early, your coverage will terminate early as well. Losses incurred after your coverage ends cannot be reimbursed.
