DAY 1 Tuesday, August 11: Depart USA

Depart St. Dominic Parish via private coach for Chicago O'Hare International Airport. Upon arrival, check in for our overnight flight to Vienna, Austria. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Wednesday, August 12: Welcome to Vienna!

This afternoon, arrive at Vienna International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Klosterneuburg Abbey, overlooking the Danube River. The abbey was founded by St. Leopold and is home of the Canons Regular. Our orientation tour will include the Abbey Church, medieval cloister, the Tomb of St Leopold, the world-famous Verdun Altar, the seven-branched candlestick of Agnes, and many other art treasures of the 14th and 15th centuries. **Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of Saint Leopold.** Independent lunch at the abbey.

Return to Vienna and check in at our hotel for a three-night stay.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY 3 Thursday, August 13: Imperial Vienna

Breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll see the most important historical sights of Vienna. **Celebrate Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral.** After Mass, we'll tour the Cathedral. Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice houses a wealth of art treasures and is dedicated to St. Stephen, the first martyr of Christendom. Then, continue our orientation tour as we pass by the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; the Capuchin Church, which contain the imperial vaults; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing the Vienna Opera, Museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater.

Independent lunch. The afternoon is free to explore Vienna on your own!
Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY 4 Friday, August 14: Excursion to Mariazell

Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we'll drive across the spectacular forested mountains, rushing streams, and small market towns to the little village of Mariazell, a favorite Viennese resort. Visit the Shrine of Mariazell. Since its founding, it has become the most popular Marian shrine in Austria, and there is a miraculous wooden statue of the Virgin Mary that is much venerated at the church. Today Mariazell Baroque church has been rebuilt several times in different architectural styles and still houses the old statue. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Mariazell.** Independent lunch with time to enjoy the quaint main square in Mariazell.

Mid-afternoon, return to Vienna.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

DAY 5 Saturday, August 15: Melk Abbey | Lake District | Salzburg

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Vienna for Melk. Enjoy magnificent scenery along the Danube in a region known as the Wachau, the pride of the historic preservation movement in Austria. At Melk, we will visit the Benedictine Abbey, crowning the rocky hill overlooking the Danube. Its library contains over 80,000 books and 2,000 manuscripts, all on religious subjects. **Celebrate Mass at Melk Abbey.** Independent lunch. This afternoon, we'll continue our scenic drive through the Austrian Lake District with marvelous views of the Salzkammergut region. In Mondsee, visit the Basilica of St. Michael, which reached international fame for the wedding scene in the movie, *The Sound of Music*. Then, continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

DAY 6 Sunday, August 16: Highlights of Salzburg

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will **celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Maria Plain** (subject to confirmation). Then we'll begin our guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings. Pass by the house where Mozart was born and view Monchsberg with the fortress "Hohensalzburg," which overlooks the city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the dynamic sculpture of the Residenzbrunnen, the largest baroque fountain north of the Alps. The Residenz building, built in 1596, was once the palace of bishops. Next, visit Salzburg Cathedral and St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery where the escape was filmed in *The Sound of Music* and most of Mozart's religious works were premiered. Independent lunch.

Late afternoon, enjoy a visit to the Bräustübl tavern and brewery, Austria's largest outdoor beer garden. The beer is drawn from wooden barrels and served in stone jugs, or steins. **Enjoy a festive group dinner in this traditional meeting place**, a piece of living history in the world heritage center of Salzburg.

Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

DAY 7 Monday, August 17: Altötting | Munich

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Salzburg for Altötting, often referred to as the " Lourdes of Germany" due to the thousands of pilgrims coming here every year for healing. Many crutches and other votives on display here testify to the healings attributed to the intercession of Our Lady of Altötting. A young Joseph Ratzinger came here with his father when growing up, and it is known to be one of his favorite shrines. Many young people from Germany make pilgrimages here in the summertime, often walking for 50 miles or more on their journey. Here, we'll see the "Black Madonna," a wooden statue of the Virgin Mary. Opposite the altar, the hearts of the Bavarian Dukes, Kings, and Electors are stored in richly decorated silver urns as a special sign of their deep loyalty to the Bavarian National Shrine. We'll also visit the Basilica of St. Anna, the Holy Chapel, the Collegiate Church, and the treasury housing the gifts donated to the Basilica. **Celebrate Mass at St. Konrad Church.** Independent lunch in Altötting. After lunch, we will depart for Munich.

Arrive in Munich, the capital of Bavaria and the second largest city in Germany. Check in at our hotel and freshen up for dinner.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Munich.

DAY 8 Tuesday, August 18: Neuschwanstein Castle | Ettal Monastery

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will leave Munich for southern Bavaria to explore King Ludwig's majestic Neuschwanstein Castle. Go back to the times of Wagner as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and Wagner's operas, the throne rooms, and music halls. Independent lunch.

Continue to Ettal Monastery, a vibrant place of prayer, community, and Benedictine tradition. Monastic life follows a centuries-old order shaped by the Rule of Saint Benedict. **Celebrate Mass at Ettal Monastery.** After Mass, enjoy a tour that will give us insight into the cloister, the daily routine of the monks, and the spiritual foundations that determine monastic life. After our tour of the monastery, we'll learn how the famous Ettal beer is brewed according to old craft traditions, followed by a tasting. Return to Munich.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Munich.

DAY 9 Wednesday, August 19: Highlights of Munich | Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning our local guide will take us to explore the highlights of Munich, including the Marienplatz and world-famous Glockenspiel; the twin-towered Frauenkirche, the most familiar landmark of old Munich; town hall; and the royal boulevard with its triumphal arch and victory gate. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady (Frauenkirche).** Independent lunch.

Evening: Free afternoon to enjoy Munich on your own.

Festive farewell dinner at a traditional Bavarian-style restaurant in Munich.

Overnight at our hotel in Munich.

DAY 10 Thursday, August 20: Return to the USA

Early morning, we will be transferred to Munich Airport for our return flight home. Arrive the same day and transfer to St. Dominic Parish by coach.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Chicago. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas and domestic round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,095.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus four (4) hotel dinners and two (2) festive group dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group
