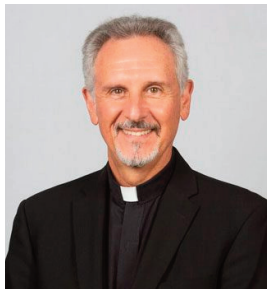

DAY 1 Monday, October 12: Depart for Malta

Depart Los Angeles International Airport for Malta, via Rome. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Tuesday, October 13: Welcome to Malta!

Evening arrival at Malta International Airport. We will be greeted and assisted by a Peter's Way Tour Manager. Gather luggage, transfer to our private motor coach, and continue to our hotel for check-in. Freshen up for dinner. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Valletta. (D)

DAY 3 Wednesday, October 14: Our Lady in Malta

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with a visit to the Basilica of Our Lady of Victories Isla, built to commemorate the Great Siege of 1565, which came to an end on September 8th. The Ottoman Empire retreated after losing more than half their army. The Maltese attribute this victory to Mary's intervention in the greatest siege in the history of Malta, which came to an end on the day we celebrate Mary's Nativity. Continue to Bormla (Cospicua), known as the city of the Immaculate Conception. Visit the Church of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception, an impressive building with ornate interior full of statues and paintings, most of which are dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Next, visit St. John's Co-Cathedral, located in the center of Valletta. The Baroque cathedral was built in the early days of Valletta's existence following the Great Siege. Independent lunch. After lunch, visit the Three Cities of Malta (Vittoriosa, Senglea, and Cospicua). The fortified cities sit like a trio of villages in the heart of Malta's historic center. Visit Marsaxlokk, derived from the Maltese words meaning South-East (xlokk) and harbor (Marsa). Visit and **celebrate Mass in the Church of Our Lady of Pompeii**. The titular painting of this parish church portrays the devotional image of Our Lady of the Rosary of Pompeii, based on an original painting in Italy. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Valletta. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, October 15: Island of Gozo

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with a visit to Gozo, Malta's sister island. The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Blessed Virgin of Ta' Pinu inspires great devotion in Gozo, where several ex-voto are displayed in remembrance of various miracles attributed to the grace of Our Lady of the Assumption. Opposite the Ta' Pinu sanctuary is Ta' Ghammar Hill, a prominent landmark on the island of Gozo, known for its scenic views and pilgrimage path, the Via Crucis. Option: Walk and pray the Stations of the Cross (steep uphill path). Independent lunch. After lunch, we will visit Victoria (Gozo's capital city) Citadel and the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. From there, we will visit and **celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Nativity of Our Lady, Xaghra**, home to a revered 17th-century statue of *Marija Bambina*, which, according to tradition, was found floating at sea. Return to Valletta. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Valletta. (B,D)

DAY 5 Friday, October 16: Our Lady and St. Paul in Malta

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with a visit to Mosta Basilica, dedicated to the Assumption of Our Lady and renowned for having the third largest unsupported dome in the world. In 2018, the church was elevated to the status of a minor basilica by decree of Pope Francis. Afterwards, we will visit Mġarr and the Parish Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. Independent lunch. Our visits in Malta are completed by venerating sites dedicated to St. Paul the Apostle. We will visit St. Paul's Church in Rabat and see the cave where St. Paul was imprisoned. Continue to Mdina Metropolitan Cathedral of St. Paul. See the mural in the apse of the cathedral that portrays the tempestuous storm that led to the shipwreck of St. Paul. St. Paul is in the forefront of the ship, looking upwards to the Eternal Father who is sending his angel to comfort the saint and reassure him that all onboard would be saved. To the right of St. Paul is St. Luke. He is also looking towards heaven, as he holds the image of the Virgin Mary and Child Jesus, which, according to legend, he painted. **Celebrate Mass in the Cathedral**. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Valletta. (B,D)

DAY 6 Saturday, October 17: Sicily

Early morning, transfer to Valletta Pier for a ferry ride to Pazzallo, Sicily. A boxed breakfast will be provided. Morning arrival at Pozzallo Pier. We will be met by our local tour guide and driver. Board our private touring bus and be on our way to Syracuse, where Paul stayed for three days after he departed Malta on his way to Rome (Acts 28:11-13). Syracuse is a small, sun-bleached provincial capital, but in ancient times it was the western capital of Magna Graecia and one of the greatest cities in the world. Many buildings from this ancient period have survived. Most are in the "archaeological zone," the town's ancient Parco Monumentale della Neapoli (Viale Rizzo). We will visit the Catacombs of John with its magnificent frescos and the crypt of Marziano, site of the first Christian Church on the island. Independent lunch. This afternoon, **celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Tears**, a place of pilgrimage, prayer, and recollection of a miracle when Mary wept from a humble plaster plaque of the Immaculate Heart in the center of the city of Syracuse. The reliquary containing Mary's tears is the focal point of the shrine. Next, visit the Duomo and the church of Santa Lucia alla Badia, located on the south side of Piazza Duomo. Inside the church is a very famous painting by Carravaggio, The Burial of St. Lucy. St. Lucy is the patroness of Syracuse. Continue to Catania for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Catania. (B,D)

DAY 7 Sunday, October 18: Catania | Zafferana Etnea | Palermo

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will reflect on the life of St. Agatha, Catania's patron saint, known for her martyrdom. One year after her death, a major eruption of Mount Etna threatened Catania. The townspeople took Agatha's veil from her tomb and held it up to the advancing lava flow, which then miraculously stopped. She is still invoked for protection against fires and eruptions. We will walk to Piazza del Duomo to **celebrate Mass in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Sant'Agata** which houses the relics of St. Agatha. After Mass, leave Catania to visit the picturesque village of Zafferana Etnea, a charming Sicilian town perched on the eastern slopes of Mount Etna, known as the "Pearl of Etna." Then, we will visit the **Gambino Vineyard for a light lunch with wine tasting** (subject to confirmation). After lunch, continue to Palermo (3-hour drive) for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Agrigento. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 Monday, October 19: Palermo

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will have a highlight tour of Palermo. Visit the Palazzo dei Normanni, once the seat of the Kings of Sicily during the Norman domination and served afterwards as the main seat of power for the subsequent rulers of Sicily. Inside are the Cappella Palatina and La Sala di Re Ruggiero, glittering chambers encrusted with mosaics of eastern influence. Continue to the Church of St. John of the Hermits (*San Giovanni degli Eremiti*), a lovely Arab-Norman church built in 1132 at the request of Norman King Roger II. It has picturesque red domes and a cloister with elegantly wrought columns and a beautiful tropical garden. End our day with **Mass at Santa Maria Assunta Cathedral**. After Mass, we will have a brief guided tour the Cathedral. Return to the hotel. Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore on your own. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Palermo. (B)

DAY 9 Tuesday, October 20: Santa Rosalia Shrine | Monreale | Cefalù

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at the Cave Church of Santa Rosalia**, patron saint of Palermo. After Mass, visit the Sanctuary that serves as the burial place and shrine to Santa Rosalia, who died in the cave in the 12th century, only to appear a few centuries later to residents of Palermo. Then, we will leave on an excursion to Monreale, site of the famous Cattedrale di Santa Maria la Nuova, built by King William II between 1172 and 1176. The most important Norman church in Sicily, the cathedral has extraordinary medieval artwork. The facade is grand but nothing compares with the vast interior, the walls of which are almost entirely covered with mosaic scenes from the Old and New Testaments. One of the most stunning depictions is the full-length figure of Christ Pantocrator. Continue to Cefalù, on the northern coast of Sicily on the Tyrrhenian Sea. Visit Cefalù Cathedral, a 12th century fortress-like structure with elaborate Byzantine mosaics and soaring twin towers. Independent lunch and free afternoon in Cefalù. Return to Palermo late afternoon and prepare for an early morning departure to Palermo Airport. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Palermo. (B,D)

DAY 10 Wednesday, October 21: Return to the USA

Early morning transfer to Palermo Airport (boxed breakfast will be provided). Check-in for our return flight to Los Angeles, via Zurich. Arrive home on the same day. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Los Angeles. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,995.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,395.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily, seven (7) dinners, plus one (1) group lunch with wine tasting.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for

local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping. **(For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred).**
